NEW HARDWOOD TIMBER (JOHNSTONE'S)	Allow the timber to naturally weather for 6 weeks. During this period, wet timber with a garden hose as regularly as possible. This will flush the natural timber tannins from the timber substrate and reduce the risk of timber tannin residue appearing once exterior oil has been applied. Alternatively, apply Johnstone's Professional Tannin & Oil Remover followed by Johnstone's Professional Deck & Timber Cleaner following label instructions. Allow to completely dry. Lightly sand timber surface. This will raise the fibres of the timber grain and provide a greater key for the Johnstone's Professional Timber Oil to adhere to
SOFTWOOD TIMBER	Ensure timber surface is dry, clean and free from dirt and debris prior to application
PREVIOUSLY PAINTED OR VANISHED TIMBER	Remove previously coated material back to bare timber using Johnstone's Professional Timber Stripper, or by
	sanding. Clean timber with Johnstone's Professional Deck & Timber Cleaner following label instructions to remove any contaminants such as mould or tannin bleed residue. Allow to completely dry prior to coating
PREVIOUSLY STAINED AND	Clean timber with Johnstone's Professional Deck & Timber Cleaner, rinse off timber substrate following label
OILED TIMBER	instructions and allow to completely dry. Lightly sand the timber surface to improve adhesion. Ensure timber is
	free from dirt, dust and contaminants prior to the application
WEATHERED AND GREY	For best results, clean timber with Johnstone's Professional Deck & Timber Cleaner following label instructions.
TIMBER DECKING	Use a high pressure washer to remove residue and allow to completely dry. Additional light sand may be
	required to remove any grey areas not removed by Johnstone's Professional Deck & Timber Cleaner. Ensure
	surface is dirt and dust free prior to the application

APPLICATION

MIXING RATES	Dilute 4:1 with water in a bucket or roller tray and apply to the timber surface with a stiff bristle brush, broom or scouring pad. Scrub Johnstone's Deck & Timber Cleaner gel into the timber with a stiff bristle brush. Leave on the surface of the timber for 10-15 minutes. If necessary apply more product or a light spray of water to keep the surface damp throughout this period. Do not allow Johnstone's Deck & Timber Cleaner to dry on the timber surface. Rinse off exterior timber surfaces thoroughly using maximum pressure from a garden hose or using a high pressure water cleaner. Allow to thoroughly dry prior to applying any further Johnstone's products
